ELIGIBILITY

- * Scholarships and awards are open to students who are entering or pursuing their post-secondary education, and who are members of the Royal Canadian Air Cadets on April 1st, 2022. Applicants who will still be in Air Cadets on April 1st, 2022 must be graduating from the Manitoba secondary school system, or already be registered at a university, college, technical institute or vocational program in the training year of application, and who are entering directly or are continuing into a full program of studies at such fully-accredited post-secondary education facility, where the program leads to a degree or diploma, or a professional or technical qualification.
- * Scholarships and awards are also open to past cadets entering their first year in post-secondary education who aged out of Cadets at age 19 between April 2nd, 2021 and April 1st, 2022. Applicants who will age out of Air Cadets because they reached 19 years of age between April 2nd, 2021 and April 1st, 2022, must be graduating from the Manitoba secondary school system in the training year of application and who are entering directly or continuing into a full program of studies at such fully-accredited post-secondary education facility, where the program leads to a degree or diploma, or a professional or technical qualification.

- * Scholarships and awards are awarded on the basis of scholastic achievement, outstanding performance as an Air Cadet, community involvement and any donor's specific requirements.
- * In any given training year, a cadet will be limited to one scholarship or one award as shown above. A cadet may apply for a scholarship or an award in successive years, bearing in mind the eligibility criteria stated, but will not be eligible to win two scholarships or two awards over that period (one scholarship and one award is acceptable).

PROCESS

- * A selection board, comprised of members of the Manitoba Honours and Awards Committee, has been appointed to consider all eligible candidates. Applicants will be considered for all the awards for which they are eligible. The Chairperson of the Honours and Awards Committee will declare the name of the recipient of the award, and a cheque will be presented to the recipient when all requirements have been satisfied. Following selection, the recipient may be requested to provide a photograph or digital image (in uniform) for purposes of publicity.
- * An award will not be finally approved until confirmation of proof of acceptance and registration at the selected post-secondary education facility has been received. In this regard, it should be noted that such proof is not required at the time of application, but that it will be required from the selected recipients as soon as possible after that determination has been made.

Note: The Honours and Awards Committee reserves the right to withhold the award if the final academic standing of the candidate is not sufficiently high.

REQUIRED INFORMATION

- * A fully completed application form (pages 4, 5, 6 and 7 of this document) must be submitted. Incomplete or missing information could well invalidate the application.
- * As well, the following are required to complete the application process:
 - A letter from the applicant providing an outline of career goals and objectives (approximately 300 words). See application for details;
 - A letter of recommendation from the Squadron Commanding Officer;
 - A letter of support from the Chairperson of the Squadron Sponsoring Committee;
 - Any other recommendations will be valuable and will be considered. i.e. School Principal, Department Head, or Counsellor;
