MULTIPLE AIR CADET SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2011

If you are an active Manitoba Air Cadet, or have aged out of the Air Cadet Program this training year, who is either:

- graduating from a Secondary School in 2011, or
- presently registered with a post secondary institution, and
- planning on pursuing further education at a post-secondary education facility (university, college or technical institute) where the program to be undertaken leads to a degree, diploma, or professional or technical qualification;

then, we have important information for you.

We are pleased to announce that you may be eligible for one of seventeen scholarships or bursaries available only to Manitoba Air Cadets this year. To find out if you are eligible or how you may apply for the awards go to our web site at www.aircadetleaguemb.ca/scholarships.html.

Manitoba Air Cadets may be awarded the following:

Ten, Post Secondary Education Scholarships sponsored by The Murphy Family Foundation at \$2,500.00 each;

Two, Manitoba Air Cadet Post Secondary Education Scholarships at \$1,000.00 each;

Five, Manitoba Squadron Leadership and Community Service Bursaries at \$500.00 each.

In addition, you may be eligible for the two National Air Cadet League Scholarships or the Hubbell Scholarship available to a Manitoba Air Cadet. Information on all these rewards is available on the web site.

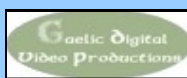

2011 MANITOBA AIR CADET BAND COMPETITION

The Air Cadet League of Canada (Manitoba) Inc. will conduct a Manitoba Air Cadet Band Competition on Sunday, 20 March 2011 at 1330 hours at Minto Armoury in Winnipeg. All Manitoba Air Cadet Squadrons are invited to participate in the competition.

There will be two classes; competition and demonstration. Each class will have two types of groups; military band and drum line. It is recommended that the minimum number of cadets for a military band is thirteen and for a drum line is three.

Competition Class. The Competition Class participants compete against other participants to be placed in a ranking order. Only the first three places of each type will be announced.

MILITARY BAND

- **Music** - perform appropriate music for General Salute, Inspection, March Past and Advance;
- **Drill** - perform appropriate drill for General Salute, Inspection, March Past, Advance and General Salute - items (1) and (2) combined not to exceed 5 minutes; and
- **Band Demonstration Routine** - perform music and band drills as chosen by each band - not to exceed 5 minutes;

DRUM LINE

- **Music** - perform music for March Past (four cadences) and Drummer's Call;
- **Drill** - perform a March Past while playing four different cadences and finishing with a stationary Drummers' Call - not to exceed 6 minutes; and
- **Drum Line Demonstration Routine** - perform drumming while executing precision drill - not to exceed 3 minutes.

DEMONSTRATION CLASS. The Demonstration Class participants - Military Band and Drum Line perform to demonstrate their progress of all or part of the Competition Class requirements. No ranking order will be given. The band or drum line may be augmented by an instructor if such augmentation will enable the cadets to participate.

Musical scores for all music must be submitted by 13 March 2011 for use by the judges.
