The 2016 Provincial Effective Speaking Competition was held on Sunday the 14th of February, 2016 in BLDG 90 at 17 Wing Winnipeg.

Twenty-two Air Cadets competed for the 2016 Manitoba Effective Speaking Competition medals. Top awards were presented to the winners by the Manitoba Provincial Committee Past Chair, Howard Mar.

The Gold medal was awarded to Corporal Aggerwal of 575 RCACS Portage La Prairie, the Silver medal was awarded to Sergeant Sukhcharhat Dhillon of 170 RCACS Winnipeg and the Bronze Medal was awarded to Sergeant Cody Lincoln of 249 RCACS Beausejour.

A special thanks to the judges, Mr. Guerrard and Mr. Best, and all the event's organizers and participants. The 2016 winner is eligible to represent Manitoba's Air Cadets in the National Effective Speaking Competition to be held in Richmond, BC this coming June.

### PROCLAMATION

#### YEAR OF THE AIR CADET IN MANITOBA

WHEREAS the Air Cadet League of Canada carries out its obligations at national, provincial and local levels with dedicated civilian members from the community and the Canadian Armed Forces providing the professional staff to implement the program; and

WHEREAS on April 9, 1941, the Air Cadet League of Canada (Manitoba) was granted a Dominion Charter authorizing it to operate as a charitable, non-profit corporation and will celebrate the seventy-fifth anniversary of its founding during the year of 2016; and

WHEREAS the first Air Cadet Squadron in Manitoba was formed in Winnipeg as "#6 Winnipeg Lions Air Cadet Squadron"; and

WHEREAS more than 55,000 young Manitobans have participated in the Air Cadet Program in Manitoba since its inception with squadrons currently located in The Pas, Swan River, Russell, Neepawa, Strathclair, Dauphin, Melita, Brandon, Morden, Portage La Prairie, Stonewall, Steinbach, Beausejour, Fisher Branch, Gimli, Thompson and Winnipeg;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that I, Andrew Swan, Special Envoy for Military Affairs, on behalf of the Government of Manitoba do hereby declare 2016 as,

#### YEAR OF THE AIR CADET IN MANITOBA

To recognize and honour seventy-five years of service to the youth of Manitoba.

## 2015 MANITOBA AIR CADET SCHOLARSHIPS

The Air Cadet League of Canada (Manitoba) Inc. is pleased to announce the 2016 Post-Secondary Scholarships. Eligibility includes students that are members of a Manitoba Squadron of the Royal Canadian Air Cadets or have aged out of the program during the Training Year 2015/16.

The 2016 awards include:

- The Lieutenant-General G. Allan Mackenzie Post-Secondary Education Bursary, a \$5,000 award – sponsored by the Lieutenant-General G. Allan MacKenzie Estate;
- The Murphy Family Foundation Scholarships, five \$2,500 awards— sponsored by the Murphy Family Foundation;
- The Manitoba Air Cadet Post--Secondary Education Scholarships, two \$1,000 awards;
- The Professor Gregory Lindahl Music Bursary, a \$500 award; plus
- The Manitoba Squadron Leadership And Community Service Bursaries, five \$500 awards—sponsored by the members of the Manitoba Provincial Committee and friends.

Cadets may be nominated for these scholarships by their Squadron Sponsoring Committee. The awards available and the guidelines for eligibility are recorded at <a href="http://www.aircadetleaguemb.ca/scholarships.html">http://www.aircadetleaguemb.ca/scholarships.html</a>.

Each applicant will be considered for all the eligible awards, but a recipient may receive only one award.

Applicants must be graduates of a Secondary School (or equivalent) system of any Province or Territory and who are entering directly into a full program of studies or are undertaking a full program at a fully-accredited post-secondary education facility (university, college or technical institute) where the program to be undertaken leads to a degree, diploma, or professional or technical qualification.
