Resolution of Cadet Day for Manitobans



An historic resolution was passed by the Manitoba Government at the Manitoba Legislature declaring, in perpetuity, Cadet Day in Manitoba-

"On June 7, Bonnie Korzeniowski, MLA for St-James and Special Envoy for Military Affairs, had a private member's resolution passed to the Manitoba Legislature, in Winnipeg, that now recognises, in perpetuity, the first Saturday in September as "Cadet Day" in Manitoba. Starting this September, all three provincial cadet Leagues will lead the activities that will promote this historic resolution. Ms. Korzeniowski commented afterwards, "this is the first time I can recall where all parties stood up and supported every part of a private member's resolution."

AVIATION & AEROSPACE DAY IN MANITOBA (AAIM DAY)

Friday, June 3, 2011 marked a milestone with the fifth annual Aerospace & Aviation Day in Manitoba (AAiM) program that brings together the aviation and aerospace communities to provide a learning experience for Grade Six students and for the first time, involved the Air Cadet League of Canada (MB). The program, as it is structured, is a one-day event at Stevenson Campus, Red River College, designed to provide career awareness activities that relate to the aviation and aerospace industries and correlate with the Manitoba Grade Six Science curriculum units on Flight and Space Science. From its inception, the program has grown to include up to 700 students from both urban and rural schools as well as private and home-school organizations.

Program: The program is run in two sections with approximately 350 students each participating in six 20-minute learning modules, in both the morning and

afternoon sessions. The program requirements and responsibilities have been laid out with each of the organizations taking a lead role in one or more of the activity centres. See: http://www.manitoba-aerospace.mb.ca/careers/development.html for an overview.

Program activities:

Aircraft Inspection: students learn to identify parts of aircraft by taking on the roles of aircraft maintenance engineers on inspection

Characteristics of Flight: students learn about the characteristics of flight and design and fly a small paper glider

Composite Materials: students learn about the latest composite materials used in aircraft and create a composite part

DC-9 Flight Theatre: students learn about the various aviation and aerospace careers through taking an imaginary flight

Rockets: students learn about rockets and design and fly a small paper rocket

Space Crater Fun: students learn about the craters and space science by creating a variety of simulated craters

The Air Cadet contingent led by Captains Stuart Smith and Chris Babcock and three Level 5 air cadets with flying scholarships were assigned to "lead" roles including group supervisors/hosts and as activity instructors in the flight activity, designing and flying paper gliders. The Air Cadets/Forces also provided a display including a CC-130 Hercules air-search-andrescue aircraft, along with learning materials for both teachers and students in a "take home" package.

The AAiM Day was an exciting and fun-filled educational experience for all the participants and for the Air Cadets, a chance to make a significant impact on a large number of young people who learned a bit more about the air cadet program. Kudos to all involved!
