ROYAL CANADIAN LEGION AIR CADET OF THE YEAR AWARD 2014

The selection of the Royal Canadian Legion (RCL) Air Cadet of the Year rotates through the provinces and territories of Canada each year. In 2014 the Royal Canadian Legion (RCL) Air Cadet of the Year has been chosen from Manitoba. This opportunity is available to Manitoba Air Cadets once every twelve years. The Air Cadet League of Canada (MB) Inc. Provincial Committee has made the selection for the 2014 Royal Canadian Legion (RCL) Air Cadet of the Year and the chosen Cadet's name has been forwarded to the Air Cadet National Office.

The Manitoba Air Cadet that has been selected will be representing all Air Cadets from across Canada at the National Remembrance Day Ceremony in Ottawa in November 2014 where the Cadet will be a member of the Vice-Regal Party (along with the RCL Army and Sea Cadet of the Year) for the National Remembrance Day Ceremonies. The Cadet will accompany the Vice-Regal Party during the Ceremonies and will assist with laying wreaths. This is a very privileged and prestigious opportunity that only one Air Cadet in Canada per year has the opportunity to participate in.

In addition the Cadet will also receive the Royal Canadian Legion Medal of Excellence and a \$500 Bursary and will participate in other ceremonies, events and visits while in Ottawa.

The selection of the chosen Cadet was a very challenging task. There were eight nominations from the Manitoba Squadrons and each Cadet nominated was a worthy competitor for this award. The competition was tight and it was a close finish, but the successful Cadet has been selected. All Cadets nominated by their Squadrons for this award should be very proud of the fact that they were their Squadron's nomination. The selection committee commends each nominee.

The name of the chosen Cadet has not been publicly released, as the Air Cadet League of Canada will be issuing an announcement naming the chosen Cadet later this summer.

The financial resources of the ACL, come from sources that include government grants, allowances and allocations, personal and corporate donations, and extensively varied fund raising activities, including those which canvass the general public. These financial resources are received with or without strings attached (e.g. some are designated 'In trust' or for specific purposes) but all financial resources are to be used to achieve the aims of the Air Cadet Program.

Since the air cadet organization raises funds from the public to support a charitable cause the source of those funds, and how we spend them are deemed to be in the public domain.

Being in the public domain requires excellent accountability and transparency. Yearly charitable returns to the Canada Revenue Agency and the League ACC9 procedures and guidelines serve those purposes.

In meeting this accountability goal, the hard work and dedication of our squadron members have achieved a new success story with the 2012/13 year's reporting. We have attained a 96% return on the ACC9 reports from Manitoba's Air Cadet Squadrons. Twenty-three of twenty-four squadrons have submitted complete reports. The one outstanding squadron is actively taking steps to correct the omission.

Our squadron Treasurers deserve an especial 'well-done' for their efforts in supporting this Provincial and National goal. You did a good job folks, thank you.
