ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL YEAR FOR MANITOBA'S AIR CADET PROGRAM

Good day. To all supporters of the Air Cadet programme in Manitoba (MB), I would like to share with you my thoughts that I sent to all of our Provincial League Liaison personnel who will have attended the twenty-four Annual cadet Review (ACR) parades for 2015. I thanked them in advance for their dedication and commitment to the Air Cadet programme, and stated that without their time and efforts, we would not be able to support the programme in Manitoba to the extent that we do, or to demonstrate to you, the Squadron sponsors and Squadron Sponsoring Committees (SSCs), military leadership and the communities that we, the League, are firmly behind the programme. We are working in concert with our DND partners, and we feel strongly that this is the best youth programme in Canada. I feel that you, as SSC members, military Officers or concerned parents or grandparents also play a major role in ensuring that the programme is relevant, viable and sustainable for the present and for many years to come.

The League commitment is something that I asked the Liaisons to talk about and expand upon, either in a formal address or in side-bars during the ACR, to ensure that the local committees and volunteers know that we are here to assist and guide in any way possible. After all, it is all for the Cadets. The lines of communication between all parties - sponsors, SSCs, Squadron Officers, and community leaders- need to be open and utilized. In the past, we have not always been the best in communicating our issues and listening to those from the squadron level, but that needs improvement, and we are committed to doing just that.

Please note that the MB Annual General Meeting will be held in October (17th and 18th) this year, and it is so important to have Squadron-level SSC and DND participation at the event, in order that we may

provide a forum at which all issues and concerns can be discussed. To our "remote" Squadrons, I remind you that the League will subsidize travel and accommodations for representatives to attend. Please strongly consider doing so.

During 2016, we will be celebrating the 75th Anniversary for the Cadets in Canada. There are League plans for celebrations and festivities in April and May of 2016, not only in Winnipeg, but as many as we can manage locally, with your cooperation and assistance, in recognition of our rural Squadrons. More will follow on this, but I urge you to support the League-sponsored Cash Calendar 2016 and the annual Raffle initiatives, as much of the money raised through these events, has and will continue to be returned to the Squadrons for your use to support your Cadet activities. We, the League, will also be speaking with Provincial and Municipal authorities to gain their understanding and recognition of the Air Cadet programme in Manitoba. Hopefully, we can have local businesses and news outlets promote the programme, and give it the recognition it deserves during 2016. Obviously, this is where you, the local SSCs and others can assist, as you will be aware of such businesses and media outlets, and can ask them to support us.

Please use every opportunity to support the Air Cadets and to improve their standing in our communities. I thank you again for your work and dedication. Let's make the Air Cadet programme in Manitoba an attractive, viable choice for our young people across the province.
