A MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR TO THE MANITOBA AIR CADET COMMUNITY

At the Local Level

It has been a very successful twelve months for the Air Cadet program in Manitoba. In October 2013, the net population of Air Cadets was up by 10% to 1,422. The Air Cadet population is usually 64% of the entire cadet program in Manitoba. In addition to the eight squadrons located in the City of Winnipeg, there are sixteen rural communities in which the Air Cadet program is delivered.

The well-being, health and success of every squadron is directly linked to the relationship among the various partners at each level. Fortunately, our squadrons are served by professional officers employed by the Canadian Forces in a partnership with the dedicated volunteer members of the Sponsoring Committees and Parent Committees. The Canadian Forces select and train the officers. The Sponsoring Committees and Parent Committees must self-generate its members almost every year. Most squadrons are presenting a wellplanned and well-managed training program. There is need for the Sponsoring Committees and Parent Committees to look into the future by implementing a succession plan to ensure a successful squadron for the future youth in their communities. Community support as demonstrated by the commitment of the Sponsoring Committees and Parent Committees is essential to a partnership that values providing the Air Cadet Program equally to all young Canadians whether in rural or urban locations.

2014 SELECTION BOARDS

The Air Cadet League National Courses Selection Boards will be held on February 15, 2014 at Building 135 at 17 Wing (Whytewold Road Entrance). Only Glider Pilot Scholarship, Power Pilot Scholarship and International Air Cadet Exchange courses will be boarded. The committee anticipates distributing the interview schedule to all squadrons no later than January 31, 2014.

Squadrons are reminded that all required documentation must be submitted to and received no later than 2359 hours 15 January 2014 by your Area Cadet Officer (Air). Due to tight timeframes the committee will not have the time or the resources to review any files that are received after this date.

The applications must also be submitted in Fortress no later than 15 January, 2014.

Additionally there are some **significant changes** in the board review selection process and cadets should be advised to carefully read and comply with the instructions, particularly the sections regarding the narrative and the appropriate documentation required to provide their academic standing. Significant points can be lost by not complying with the instructions provided.
