#### MEMBERSHIP RESTRUCTURE

The 2014 Annual General Meeting of the Corporation held on October 19, 2014 approved the Eighth amendment to the Corporation's by-laws which restructured the membership to a more practicable structure for our program at this time. There now shall be five classes of members in the Corporation as follows: Board Members; Sponsoring Organization Members; Life Members; Members at Large; and Honorary Members.

The biggest changes are: the reduction in the number of Board members from 25 to 15, including the executive, which will facilitate decision making, in particular achieving a quorum at meetings; and the inclusion of the Members at Large group, which will be called upon to function as members of sub-committees to assist in operating the various programs for which the corporation is responsible. The Members at Large group with an unlimited number of volunteers will attract persons interested in air cadet matters but whose limited time availability precludes their involvement at the Board level. They will now be able to contribute in specific activities of their interest and at their convenience.

Our dynamic program offer opportunities to those in the community interested in assisting in the activities that flesh out the mandatory Air Cadet Program.
