WORD FROM THE CHAIR Doug McLennan

As you are all aware, we held our 2015 Annual General meeting on October 17 and 18 at the Holiday Inn West, and it was very good to see that 16 of our 24 Squadrons were represented during the weekend. We held training sessions for our Squadron Sponsoring Committees (SSCs), in concert with our Canadian Forces partners from the Regional Cadet Support Unit (Northwest). From the feedback we have heard to date, these sessions were well received, and should be continued in future years. We will do this, but will look at a slightly different format, putting more emphasis on the interaction between SSCs to allow a better information follow on best practices and good ideas.

At the Saturday evening Awards Dinner, we presented awards totalling \$3000 to deserving Squadrons, and scholarships and bursaries totalling over \$22,000 to deserving Cadets from Squadrons across the province. Another highlight was the awarding of the Honorary Air Marshall Award, to Mrs Valerie MacKenzie, "In recognition of exceptional personal achievement by an individual whose accomplishments have the motivational and inspirational value to serve as a positive role model for the youth of Manitoba". My sincere congratulations to all the recipients.

We were joined at the AGM by the Air Cadet League of Canada National President, Mr Don Doern and his wife Penny. It was indeed a pleasure to host them for the weekend.
